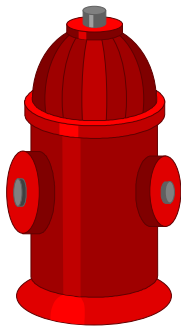
Since 1990 he has been involved with EPI's field installation crews installing geomembranes for landfills, waste water lagoons, landfill caps, and decorative ponds.
